		The most interesting caves of Island Island, though lacking in karst-prone rocks, has many interesting caves. Small lava tubes are present all over the country. The longest cave of this origin, Surtshellir-Stepanshellir, is ca. 3,5 km long. Another big one, Vidgimir, is available only for fee and with a guide. Grotagja and Storagja formed by the collapse of a basalt plate along a tectonic fault. Both offer hot bath in their thermal lakes. Huge caves are created by thermal waters in Island glaciers; they change with time quite rapidly. Lodowiec = glacier, nieistniejąca = not exist, kopalnia = mine	lava, Iceland

		Lava tubes of the Reykjanes Peninsula - The author became interested in caves by visiting Raufarhólshellir in Island, where he lives. He, and some other Poles living there too, he created a Polish caving club in Island – Polski Klub Wulkanu. They have hitherto penetrated some 70 lava tubes, mainly on the Reykjanes Peninsula. A few of them are described in this article. Búri is one of the Earth's widest tubes, up to 10 m in diameter. The final lava fall, shaped as a pitch 13 m deep, is the deepest lava shaft known. The other caves have various characters, some are maze-like, some include colourful lava falls, one is geothermally heated to about 20°C.	Iceland

The legendary cave diver Jochen Hasenmayer played an important role in the exploration of Keld Head, where he was involved in the notorious 'Dead Man's Handshake' incident (Geoff Yeadon's side of the story can be heard in this [interview](#)). This interview, in German, was originally conducted over the phone for an Icelandic [radio documentary](#) made by Jan Murtomaa. The questions were formulated by Jan in English, and translated and presented by Hjálmar Sveinsson in German. The English [transcript](#) was kindly created by Chris Snuggs. In this interview Jochen describes how his development of new equipment allowed him to continually push the boundaries of cave diving, even after a decompression incident left him paraplegic.
