2024 Membership fees

The BCA is pleased to announce that for another year there will be no increase in membership fees for 2024.

Current BCA membership fees are Clubs:

- £25 for club membership
- £60 extra for clubs with huts, or those that control access to a cave or mine. (but clubs that do both only need to pay this once)

Club or individual BCA members for a full year membership:

- £20 for caving membership
- £6 for non-caving membership
- £8 for a full time student membership
- Free of charge for all under 18s.

Please remember you can update the BCA on new members/ re-joiners at any point throughout the year but as a minimum should be updating your membership details quarterly.

Look out for: BCRA membership rates for 2024 will soon be confirmed and communicated to all members.

BCA getting greener..... by sending out less green

The BCA has decided to be more green, by posting out less green (and other colour!) plastic cards. From 2024 we will be sending out e-cards to our members, via club representatives for club members. These will provide the same information as on the plastic cards and will be in a form that can be saved on a mobile device, or printed if need be.

Currently the BCA prints and posts over 7000 plastic cards per year. As well as the impact of these cards, that are in use for a single year, there is also a large amount of envelopes and packaging associated with distributing these.

Over 4500 of these are green club cards that club representatives then have to distribute to their members. So hopefully the new e-cards will make things easier and cheaper for clubs to distribute to their membership!

We are sure the majority of our membership will embrace this change and readily adapt to the e-cards. However for 2024 and, only whilst card stocks last, we may be able to supply plastic cards to clubs/ members who specifically feel they need one and request one.

trips and the amount donated approaches £300,000.

Ghar Parau card sets that can be bought at £8 for 10 or £15 for 20, they are splendid photographs taken by some of the best cave photographers around. There is no message inside so are perfect for any occasion. 100% of the monies raised goes into sponsoring UK cavers as GPF is run entirely by volunteers.
